#### What happens next?

A member of staff will speak to you and arrange a full housing assessment. This is to agree your personal housing plan and the session will be between 1 and 2 hours.

You will then be sent a letter letting you know if you're eligible for housing support. This can take up to 56 days, but they can usually let you know sooner than this.
