Help with Debt

If you are worried about money or debt, it can seem very confusing where to turn for help.

However, there are many independent agencies across Leeds providing free and confidential advice.

This page contains details of all local and nation organisations offering free advice and support on debt, money and benefits.

There are also details organisations which can assist anyone experiencing gambling related harm, domestic violence and financial abuse.



Better Leeds Communities Advice Service

They offer free advice for anyone living in Leeds including help with debt as well as benefits, housing and fuel poverty.

This is a local charity based in Burmantofts that gives free, confidential and impartial advice in relation to debt.

If you are facing eviction, bailiffs at your door, doorstep collectors, County Court Judgements or just not managing to pay your debts then they can represent you, advise you on your rights and provide a casework service where they negotiate a realistic repayment program for you.

They also have a team of volunteers known as Leeds Money Buddies who can provide one to one help.

They can help you follow the debt advice you've been given, work on your budget, help input information on to a computer, print letters off for your creditors, maximise your income and fill out forms to apply for grants.

They can also look online for you to find the cheapest gas and electric supplier and will chat about the most up to date ways on how to save money. Call them on **0113 235 0276** or email admin@egac.org
