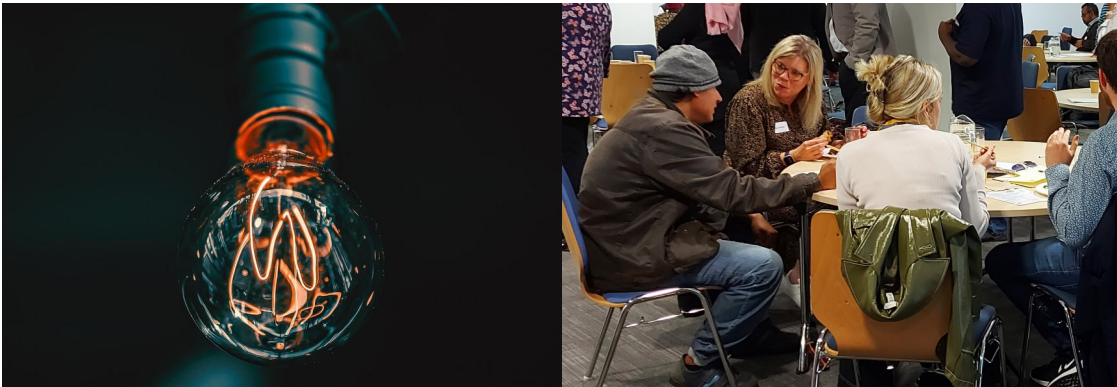




Any good ideas for funding your advocacy?

Funding priorities

There are grants available of between £500 and £10,000 for community groups in Leeds to help boost advocacy. It will prioritise:

- Advocacy that helps people to be more included and overcome barriers
- Support for friends/relatives/carers to be informal advocates
- Smaller and 'unconstituted' groups
