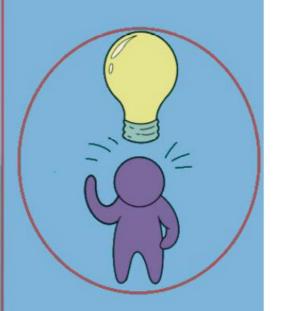


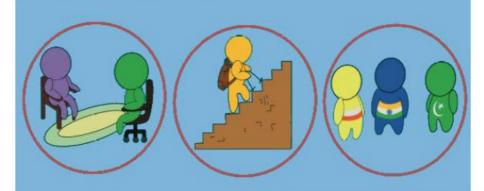




## OUR SERVICE—HOW AN ADVOCATE CAN HELP YOU:

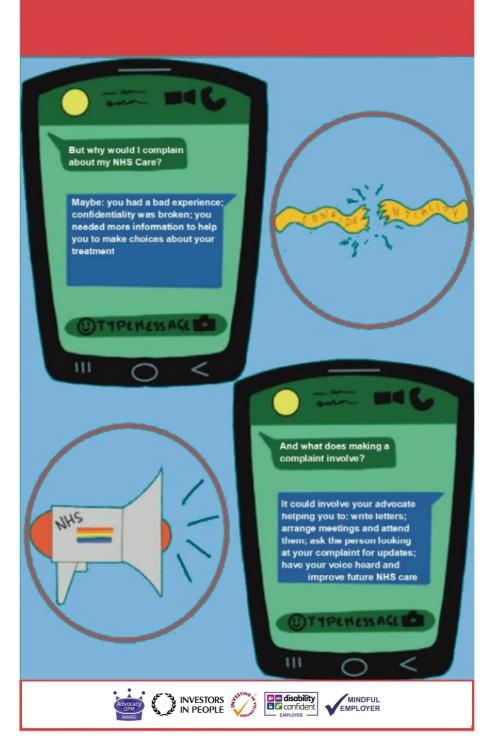
