




Advocacy Service

- Supports clients to access services and engage with organisations.
- Operates at a time when our ESOL and wellbeing classes also run so that people who are accessing these groups can speak to us.
- Trained advocacy staff and volunteers can help clients overcome both language and cultural barriers to accessing services.
- Strong links with both our Refugee Community Organisations and other organisations supporting Refugees and Asylum Seekers in Leeds.

Advocacy Support Fund from Advonet

Active recruitment of staff and volunteers, targeting those with languages spoken by clients.

Funded 3 part-time members of staff. 6 volunteers include Tigrinya, Arabic, Kurdish Sorani and Farsi.

Developed skills and confidence of staff and volunteers.



544 appointments in 2024 (370 in 2023)






